PLEASE READ AND TAKE NOTE BEFORE SIGNING AGREEMENT BELOW:

Active Membership: To be considered an active member, individual must (1) attend a minimum of one club meeting per year and (2) volunteer at two DOI trials per year or serve on the Trial Committee for one DOI trial per year or serve on the Board.

Aggressive Dog Policy: Dogs that are aggressive toward other dogs or people are not allowed in classes on DOI fields. Dogs deemed to be aggressive will be asked to leave the premises. Handler is responsible for the dog at all times.

Benefits of Membership: All members receive priority access to classes at the DOI field, receive title plaques and bars for USDAA titles at club expense, and are invited to the annual Holiday Party. Active members are eligible for participation on DOI DACOF teams (with trial-ready dogs) and can choose to become field members, which includes unlimited access to DOI equipment at the DOI field.

General Release Information:

I (we) agree to abide by the rules, regulations and by-laws of the Dog On It Agility Club of Central Florida. **When attending classes or using the equipment at the DOI field, I (we) agree to abide by the Field Rules included on the last two pages of this form.** I (we) further agree to hold Dog On It Agility Club of Central Florida, its agents and instructors, and the leaser of this property, NOCIA, and any employees or contractors of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person, possession or thing while upon the property, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for the loss of their pet by any disappearance, theft, death, or otherwise and from any claim for damage or injury to their pet. **Whether any loss be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the property owners or any of the aforementioned parties, I (we) assume all responsibility for any such loss or expense.** This release form will remain in effect permanently unless otherwise waived by the property owners/Dog On It Agility Club.

FIELD RULES

Hours of Operation: 24 hours per day, 7 days per week, except when reserved for classes or special events.

Who May Use: Only field members, authorized instructors, or students during classes taught by authorized instructors.

Safety First: Do not allow your dogs on the equipment unless you are taking or have taken agility classes and know the safe way to train your dog. DOI is not responsible for injuries incurred from use or misuse of the equipment.

Only one dog off leash in a ring at a time. Other dogs must be under restraint and supervision of owner (i.e. leash, crate, x-pen, owner's arms, etc.). If a dog is tied out, it must be at least 10 feet from the agility rings. If a dog is left in a vehicle, it must not be able to leave the vehicle. All dogs on premises must be current on vaccinations, as recommended by their veterinarian.

Sharing the Practice Ring: If more than one person is present, practice no more than 10 minutes per person and take turns.

General Rules:

Only Dog On It equipment may be used. Equipment rented to another instructor may not be used by members except in that instructor's classes.

Pick up after your dogs and dispose of your trash.

Dogs should not eliminate in the agility ring or on the equipment. Clean any equipment that is soiled.

Discard trash and dog waste in the trash can. This applies to anywhere on the premises, whether inside or outside of the fenced area.

No overnight parking or camping other than permitted R.V.s at a show or match.

To create a more healthy environment, please refrain from smoking or drinking alcoholic beverages in or near the agility field.

No open fires permitted on the premises at any time.

No sustained loud noise after 11:00 PM.

Everyone must comply with state, county, and municipal laws and ordinances.

When leaving the field:

1. Tuck the chute in the barrel.
2. All contact equipment should be left in a usable condition a minimum of 10 feet away from the fence line.
3. Turn off lights.
4. Turn off water faucet if turned on, and empty swim pool.
5. Make sure trash is disposed of properly.
6. VERY IMPORTANT: Lock all gates to practice field.

Enforcement: Any violations of the club's policies should be reported to the Board of Directors. Members who violate these rules may have their field privileges revoked without refund.

Non-members: Club members may bring the same guest twice in one year at no cost, but after that, the guest will be required to join the club and become a field member if they would like to continue to use the field for practice.
