DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete.

Condition of the Dog. Dogs with physical challenges(including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Dogs with bandages, sutures, or visible wounds are not eligible. Deaf dogs and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Dogs that are both deaf and blind are able to participate so long as the handler is in control of the dog at all times, the dog can complete the requirements of the class, and the dog does not appear to be under undue stress in the opinion of the judge.

No entries will be accepted by phone, email, fax, or hand delivery. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. Inquiries may be directed to Cindy Deak at k9trialsecretary@gmail.com. No entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be shredded. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and will incur \$25.00 collection fee.

Entries not admitted to the trial and withdrawn entries will be shredded; no checks will be returned.

WAIT LIST INFORMATION

A wait list of 50 runs per trial will be maintained until the waitlist closing date listed on page 1, after which time, no changes, alterations, substitutions, or backfills will be made to the trial entry list. Any runs not admitted to the trial by the Wait List Close Date above will be shredded.

CLOSING DATE. No entries may be withdrawn with a refund after closing. All entries must be received by trial closing. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial will receive a full refund. If you do not wish to commit to a run you must withdraw from the wait list before trial closing.

STAGING AREA, HANDLER'S BRIEFING, AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Staging Area will be out of view of search area(s). Staging area will include crating, warm-up and waiting area, as well as the secretary table for check-ins and posting of running order and results.

A **Handler's Briefing** will take place in view of the search area prior to the start of each class, after the hide(s) have been set and after the Demo Dog has run. In the Handler's Briefing the judge will explain if there's an off-leash option, number of hides, maximum height of hides and maximum time for the search. NO DOGS are to be present during the Handler's Briefing.

Warm-up area: The club shall designate a warm-up area. One labeled container per target odor being used in the trial on that day will be placed in the warm-up area. This will allow handler-dog teams to prepare themselves for the search prior to their run. Each team should limit their warm-up to two minutes or less so that others may be able to use the warm-up area as well. Clubs may also place blank containers.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Trial Limit: All trials limited to 125 runs per judge.

Trial Site: It is not appropriate to scout the trial location prior to the trial date. Many search locations are real-life environments and such visits may risk the host losing the opportunity to use the location in the future.

Potty Area: Designated potty areas will be pointed out during the General Briefing. Portable restrooms will be in use.

Exhibitors are responsible for using appropriate potty area and cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

Possession of Odors and Training: Chapter 5. Section 35 of the Scent Work Regulations state "No person other than those engaged in the administration of a trial shall be in possession of any target odor when on the trial grounds. There shall be no training on the grounds of the AKC Scent Work trial, other than the designated warm-up area".

Spectator Area: Spectators are allowed only in designated search areas. Any person not handling a dog in the current class, or any person who has already completed their run in the class may choose to watch the search from the spectator area. Handlers may not watch other exhibitors from their class prior to their run. No one outside the search area may assist the handler or disclose the location of the hide. Spectators who intentionally or unintentionally give aid to a team may be asked to leave the area by the judge. Spectators are forbidden to discuss details of the search with handlers who have not run.

Crating space Crating will be from your personal vehicle. There is plenty of room for shade tents which may be left overnight.

Parking: Ample parking is available. There are several RV hookups available and RV dry camping also available. Contact <a href="mailto:normatics.normatics

Smoking and Alcohol: The grounds are a smoke and alcohol-free area. You may smoke in your own vehicle away from other exhibitors with all windows and doors closed.

Food and Concessions: No food will be available for purchase on site. Please bring your own food and drinks. There are multiple fast food restaurants nearby.

Day to day move ups will be offered. AKC move up form must be received no later than 30 minutes after the last dog runs each day by the Trial Secretary.

A New Title rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title.

A Super Sniffer ribbon will be awarded to dog and handler teams that qualify in all four odor division elements (container, buried, exterior, interior), regardless of level split, in a single trial.

Ribbons and prizes will not be mailed.

HIGH IN TRIAL & HIGH COMBINED DIVISION

HIT: Teams must enter and qualify in all standard tilting elements offered that day (3 per day) within the same level. HIT is awarded to the team with the fewest faults and fastest cumulative time. HIT is awarded in each level. Novice A and B are scored together and only one HIT will be awarded for Novice. Handler must be present to win.

Teams winning HIT will earn a special ribbon.

High Combined Division If a club chooses to offer the High in Trial (HIT) award and is also offering Handler Discrimination classes, they must also confer the High Combined Division (HCD) awards. Only teams who participate in the same difficulty level in all elements plus Handler Discrimination, and qualify in each, are eligible to win High Combined Division. The High Combined Division award is determined by adding a team's faults across all classes. The team with the fewest faults will be declared the winner of the High Combined Division. The High Combined Division award is not recorded by the AKC.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR AND LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Dog-On-It Agility Club of Greater Orlando, Inc. and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Dog-On-It Agility Club of Greater Orlando, Inc. reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Dog-On-It Agility Club of Greater Orlando, Inc. or any official thereof.

Collars, Leashes and Harnesses: While not actively searching, dogs MUST be on a fixed length 6' or shorter leash, INCLUDING entering and exiting search areas in order to avoid dog to dog contact. During searches, dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge. A wearable camera such as a Go Pro may be mounted to the dog's harness, if desired. Leashes may be of any length and/or retractable. The leash should be made of plain, pliable material.

Dogs must be on leash at all times, and retractable leashes may not be used when on trial grounds (except during judged searches). Dogs must enter and exit the search area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting in the search area before and after the search. An off-leash option may be offered at the discretion of the judge, only if the area is completely enclosed.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical condition are not eligible for a refund.

Bitches in season will be refunded the full entry fee. Notification in writing must be given to the trial secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial.

Refunds due prior to closing Entries paid by check will be shredded NOT returned.

WITHDRAWALS MADE AFTER CLOSING that are legally eligible for refund as described above will be processed after the trial has concluded. Refunds due by check will be sent within 3 weeks of the trial date.

Entries not admitted to the trial and withdrawn entries will be shredded, not returned to the exhibitor.

RINGSIDE

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the search area when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

EXHIBITOR CHECK-IN: Check-In will be at the facility starting an hour before the trial starts.

Exhibitors MUST check-in EACH day they are entered.
Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

"Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations."
