DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete.

Dogs with physical challenges Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Dogs with bandages, sutures, or visible wounds are not eligible. Deaf dogs and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Dogs that are both deaf and blind are able to participate so long as the handler is in control of the dog at all times, the dog can complete the requirements of the class, and the dog does not appear to be under undue stress in the opinion of the judge. (Chapter 2, Section 3 of the Scent Work Regulations).

Element classes will run Novice thru Master with Trial 1 and Trial 2 running concurrently.

Event Results: Preliminary results are posted as soon as results are entered. Please remember that you must verify the posted results PRIOR to leaving the event for the day. Results posting may be delayed for pending information from the judge or the Secretary may be competing. If you choose to leave the site prior to verifying your results, **no changes can be made after the end of the trial day**. No changes will be made to results by emails, text or any communication other than in person the day of the event at the site.

ENTRY FEES

No entries will be accepted by phone, fax, or electronic means except as detailed below. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. Inquiries may be directed to Trial Secretary Cindy Deak, k9trialsecretary@gmail.com. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Entries not admitted to the trial by closing and withdrawn entries will be shredded. No checks will be returned.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be shredded. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of such entries. **ALL checks received will be deposited at closing.**

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. **Dogs pulled after closing** because of injury or other medical condition are not eligible for a refund.

Bitches in season will be refunded the full entry fee. Notification in writing must be given to the trial secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of each trial. Refunds will be mailed after completion of the trial.

No refunds will be issued for \$10 or less.

Safety

Anyone in violation of a restriction pursuant to AKC rules or policies, or the law can be asked to leave the grounds. If the person fails to leave, the local authorities will be contacted. In addition, if the club believes laws, restrictions, or conditions of release are being violated by an individual's attendance or participation in AKC events, the local authorities will be contacted immediately as they have the authority of enforcement.

CLASSIFICATIONS

Novice A Classes are open to dogs who have not completed any title for that particular element, who have not completed a comparable title with another organization, and whose handlers are neither Scent Work judges, nor have ever worked as professional detection dog handlers.

Novice B Classes are open to all dogs.

Advanced Classes are open to dogs who have achieved the Novice title for that particular element. **Excellent Classes** are open to dogs who have achieved the Advanced title for that particular element. **Master Classes** are open to dogs that have achieved the Excellent title for that particular element.

Detective class is open to dogs who have achieved a Master title in any Odor Element.

Handler Discrimination classes are titling classes in which the targeted scent is that of the handlers themselves.

Handlers are required to provide their own scented articles in a plastic bag. For the Novice class, one cotton glove or cotton sock, for Advanced, Excellent, and Master, cotton balls or cotton swabs. Three qualifying scores are required to earn titles in each class. Handlers may utilize any method to scent their article except by applying oils used for Odor elements.

SEARCH AREA AND RING CONDITIONS

Search Area Conditions. Searches may be indoors, on concrete, matted, carpeted, tiled or other suitable surface, or outdoors on grass, gravel, earth, concrete, or asphalt surfaces. This facility is ADA accessible throughout.

Search Area Sizes Refer to the Scentwork Regulations for search area sizes and other requirements. Search areas may be of any shape and of the size specified in the Regulations for each class.

Exhibitors MUST check-in for each trial in which they are entered. *Time listed are approximate and may change after entries close or on the day of trial.*

Notice to Exhibitors

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Dog-On-It Agility Club of Greater Orlando and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Dog-On-It Agility Club of Greater Orlando, Inc.. reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Dog-On-It Agility Club of Greater Orlando, Inc. or any official thereof.

Collars, Leashes and Harnesses: While not actively searching, dogs MUST be on a fixed length 6' or shorter leash, INCLUDING entering and exiting search areas. During searches, dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge. A wearable camera such as a Go Pro may be mounted to the dog's harness, if desired. Leashes may be of any length and/or retractable. The leash should be made of plain, pliable material.

STAGING AREA, HANDLER'S BRIEFING, AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Staging Area will be out of the view of the search areas. Staging area will include crating, warm-up and waiting areas as well as the secretary table for checking of results. No smoking on the premises allowed.

PARKING Ample parking is available. No RV parking.

Dog exercise Area Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

Handlers Briefing will be conducted prior to each class and level. There will be a group briefing prior to the start of each day's judging.

Warm-up Area One labelled container per target odor being used in the trial on that day will be placed in the warm-up area. This will allow handler-dog teams to prepare themselves for the search prior to their run. Each team should limit their warm-up to two minutes or less so that others may be able to use the warm-up area as well. The warm-up area is not for training or relieving of the dog. (Chapter 5, Section 34 of the Scent Work Regulations).

Trial Site. It is not appropriate to scout the trial location prior to the trial date. Many search locations are real-life environments and such visits may risk the host losing the opportunity to use the location in the future. (Chapter 3, Section 15 of the Scent Work Regulations).

Crating: Crating will be indoors. Empty crates can be left overnight. DOI, OCOD is not responsible for items left overnight

Food and Concessions: No concessions available. There are nearby restaurants.

Possession of Odors and Training. Chapter 5, Section 35 of the Scent Work Regulations state "No person other than those engaged in the administration of a trial shall be in possession of any target odor when on the trial grounds. There shall be no training on the grounds of the AKC Scent Work trial, other than the designated warm-up area".

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

All prizes and ribbons must be claimed day of the show. None will be mailed or otherwise distributed.

Placement ribbons will be awarded in each class as follows:

New Title Rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title.

Detective Title Rosette will be offered toa dog and handler team completing their Detective Title at this event.

Super Sniffer ribbon will be awarded to dog and handler treams that qualify in all four odor division elements, regardless of level split in a single trial.

HIGH IN TRIAL & HIGH COMBINED DIVISION

High In Trial: Teams must enter and qualify in all standard tilting elements offered that day within the same level. HIT is awarded to the team with the fewest faults and fastest cumulative time. HIT is awarded in each level. Novice A and B are scored together and only one HIT will be awarded for Novice. If there is a tie based on faults, the team with the fastest times across the elements will be named High in Trial. The High in Trial award is not recognized by AKC.

Teams winning HIT and HC will earn a special ribbon.

High Combined Division: Only teams who participate in the same difficulty level in all elements plus Handler Discrimination, and qualify in each, are eligible to win High Combined Division. The High Combined Division award is determined by adding a team's faults across all classes. The team with the fewest faults will be declared the winner of the High Combined Division. The High Combined Division award is not recorded by the AKC.

I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim of loss, injury or damage to this dog.
