



Dear Members & Applicants,

For new and renewing members, complete and submit this form to the Club Secretary listed below on the form, due **August 1, 2026** and no later than August 31, 2026 to maintain membership status. Payment must also be sent to the Club Treasurer and may be made via PayPal, Zelle, or Check.

As a club, we depend on our members to support our activities so that we can be successful. In order for our club to grow, we need members to participate in decisions involving our future by attending club meetings, participating and helping with trials, and supporting seminars or fun events.

The main sources of funding for this non-profit organization are hosting agility trials and payment of membership dues. These funds are used to cover the costs of rent of our fields, equipment maintenance, and purchase of needed equipment and supplies. Other activities such as fun matches, lessons and dog training may be employed to contribute to fundraising. We ask all members to participate in the club by volunteering at DOI trials, serving on the board, or participating in events at the training field. **THE CLUB CANNOT EXIST WITHOUT EVERYONE'S PARTICIPATION.**

Benefits of membership:

- All members in good standing receive access to the DOI fields, from 7am to 10pm (subject to availability),
- Priority access to all classes at the DOI fields,
- Discounts on classes and seminars taught at the DOI fields,
- Title plaques for USDAA and AKC titles,
- An invitation to the annual Holiday Party & Awards Night,
- Actively volunteering & active members are eligible for participation on DOI's DACOF team(s) with trial-ready dogs (non-active members may be expected to pay their own entry fee for DACOF).

Membership Options:

There are several membership options available for any person 18 or older, which also includes a family membership option with the appropriate level, and a Junior Handler membership for members younger than 18 years of age. The cost of each reflects the level of participation expected of club members. Each level of membership requires an application submission with the appropriate fee (\$), a waiver (includes guest activity), and listing a sponsor to be signed and submitted to the corresponding year's Club Secretary. We are excited to have you join us for training, companionship, and fun with your four-legged friends and club members!

Gold Membership - This level reflects the full charter of the organization. DOI is a club and, as such, members are expected to share the benefits as well as the burdens required to maintain the organization. The Gold membership level is the more interactive membership, hence the discount that benefits the activity accordingly.

Requirements: During the year, must attend one (1) club meeting, participate in at least one club-sponsored activity (ie work at a trial or other club activity, serve as a Board member, or become Field Manager or Training Director).

Benefits: Field use with priority over Silver-level members for field scheduling should that situation occur.

Cost: \$50 per year

Silver Membership - This level is for those individuals who do not plan to participate in fund raising or club maintenance activities, hence the higher cost on a yearly basis.

Requirements: None.

Benefits: Field use, unless occupied by a Gold-level member or previously scheduled event.

Cost: \$100 per year

Family Membership – This level is for adults and minors, residing under the same household/residence. Similar to the Gold-level, this membership allows family members (2 or more individuals) the same benefits at a slight discount.

Requirements: During the year, must attend one (1) club meeting, participate in at least one (1) club-sponsored activity (ie work at a trial or other club activity).

Benefits: Field use with priority over Silver-level members.

Cost: \$75 per year

Junior Membership – We want to support the youth in our community by encouraging any young persons that desire to pursue the sport of dog agility and other dog sports. Junior handlers are the future of dog sports, and as such, we encourage any individuals under the age of 18 to join our club. An adult/guardian must sponsor and accompany the minor at all times when on DOI property for classes or training.

Requirements: The junior and chaperone must attend one (1) club meeting per year, participate in at least one (1) club-sponsored activity for the year.

Benefits: A reduced price from the single-person Gold membership. Field use with priority over Silver-level members.

Cost: \$35 per year

General NOCIA/DOI rules:

Because we rent our section of property from NOCIA that contain the agility fields, we are required to adhere to their rules pertaining to this location. Please respect all buildings and aspects within the perimeter of the property.

- No overnight parking or camping [other than permitted RVs or tents at a show or match].
- To create a healthier environment, please refrain from smoking or drinking alcoholic beverages in or near the agility fields.
- No open fires permitted on the premises at any time.
- No sustained loud noise after 10:00pm.
- Everyone must comply with state, county, and municipal laws and ordinances.

When leaving the field:

- All contact equipment should be left in a usable condition, returned to full height if lowered, and at minimum of 10 feet away from the fence line.
- Put away all numbering cones and return equipment taken from another field or dugout.
- Turn off all lights.
- Turn off water faucet if it is on, and empty puppy pool.
- Ensure trash is disposed of properly.
- VERY IMPORTANT: Lock the gate to the fields. There are two locks on the gate, NOCIA's and DOI's. Lock DOI's padlock through NOCIA's in a way that the gate may be opened when either lock is removed.

Enforcement:

- Any violations of the club's policies should be reported to the Board of Directors immediately. Members who violate these rules may have their field privileges revoked without refund.

General Information Regarding Field Use

Hours of Operation:

- 7 days per week, 7am to 10pm, except when reserved for classes or special events. Please be aware of Orange County noise ordinances.

Who May Use:

- Only DOI members (see below regarding guests/non-members), authorized instructors, or students during classes taught by authorized instructors.
- All dogs on premises must be current on vaccinations, as recommended by their veterinarian.

Non-members:

- Club members may bring the same guest twice in one year at no cost, but after that, the guest will be required to join the club if they would like to continue to use the field for practice. In any circumstance, visitors must sign a release.

Safety First:

- Do not allow your dogs on the equipment unless you are currently taking, have taken agility classes, or have proven to the Equipment Manager, another Board Member, or another DOI club member proficient in the use of our field and equipment that you know the safe way to train your dog. DOI is not responsible for injuries incurred from use or misuse of the equipment.
- You must sign a waiver form removing DOI and NOCIA from all liability upon membership acceptance, or at the time of membership renewal.
- No flexi-leashes allowed on premises at any time.
- Electronic training collars and/or prong collars may not be permitted anywhere on the premises, especially should an ongoing trial be occurring at that time (as per AKC rules and policies).

Aggressive Dog Policy:

- Dogs that are aggressive toward other dogs or people are not allowed in any classes on DOI fields. Dogs deemed to be aggressive will be asked to leave the premises.
- Handler is responsible for the dog at all times.

Ring Use:

- Only one dog off leash in a ring at a time. Other dogs must be under restraint and supervision of owner (i.e. leash, crate, x-pen, owner's arms, etc.). If a dog is tied out, it must be at least 10 feet from the agility rings.
- If a dog is left in a vehicle, it must be crated and not be able to leave the crate, and must be appropriately weather safe at all times (ie not sealed in a vehicle during high temperatures).
- If more than one person is present, practice no more than 10 minutes per person and take turns.
- Only Dog-On-It equipment may be used. Equipment rented to another instructor may not be used by members except in that instructor's classes.
- Pick up after your dogs and dispose of your trash in designated bins. Dogs should not eliminate in the agility ring or on the equipment. Clean any equipment that is soiled. Discard trash and dog waste in the trash can. This applies to anywhere on the premises, whether inside or outside of the fenced area – DO NOT ALLOW YOUR DOG TO SOIL ANY MAN-MADE MATERIALS.
- Offenders will be prosecuted according to our bylaws.

Release of Liability and Hold Harmless Waivers

Waiver of Liability and Informed Consent:

I understand that participation in dog training activities is not without risk to myself, members of my family or guests who may attend, or to my dog even when dogs are handled with the greatest of care. I hereby waive and release Dog-On-It Agility Club (hereafter called DOI), its officers, members and agents from any and all liability of any nature, for injury, illness or damage which I or my dog may suffer. I certify that any and all dogs I bring to the Club facility are protected against kennel cough, rabies, distemper and parvo as recommended by my veterinarian and as required by law. I acknowledge that Dog-On-It Agility Club has a no aggressive dog(s) policy, and an instructor and/or the Club reserve the right to dismiss from class any handler or dog whom, in the instructor's

and/or the Club's opinion, exhibits inappropriate behavior. I agree that I am visiting the Dog-On-It Agility Club class, ring rental, event or for any other reason entirely at my own risk and take full responsibility for my own health and safety during this attendance as well as my dog(s) health and safety. I hereby waive any legal claims against the aforementioned organization and individuals, including any claims for negligence, failure to warn, or any other claims for damages or personal injury. I assume all financial liability for myself, and I will pay any financial costs associated with my actions.

General Release Information:

- I (we) agree to abide by the rules, regulations and bylaws of the Dog-On-It Agility Club of Central Florida.
- When attending classes or using the equipment at the DOI field, I (we) agree to abide by the Field Rules included on this form.
- I (we) further agree to hold Dog-On-It Agility Club of Central Florida, its agents and instructors, and the leaser of this property, NOCIA, and any employees or contractors of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person, possession or thing while upon the property, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for the loss of their pet by any disappearance, theft, death, or otherwise and from any claim for damage or injury to their pet.
- Whether any loss be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the property owners or any of the aforementioned parties, I (we) assume all responsibility for any such loss or expense.
- This release form will remain in effect permanently unless otherwise waived by the property owners and Dog-On-It Agility Club.
- By sending in the membership form and paying dues, you are agreeing to abide by these rules.
