This trial is accepting online entries through LabTestedOnline.com.

During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows. 175 runs online (50%), 175 runs paper (50%) each day. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48-hour period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly. To enter online, the exhibitor must create an account and add his/her dogs at LabTestedOnline.com. The initial 6 months are free. After that, there's a \$10 annual fee to continue using the site. LabTestedOnline.com adds a 5% service fee to the total entry fee to cover the credit card processing cost.

Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

Opening Date:06/16/2026 8:00 a.m. EST

Closing Date: 09/13/2026 8:00 p.m. EST

Entry Fees: Entries are First Received. A maximum of 10 entries per envelope is allowed. Envelopes with more than 10 entries and/or entries received prior to opening date will be returned.

No entries will be accepted by phone, fax, email or hand delivery. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$25 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Cancellation of Entries before Closing: Entries cancelled before closing will not be charged any processing fees. Entry checks will be shredded.

AFTER CLOSING WAITLIST

A waitlist will be maintained for these trials once they have closed on March 13, 2026. The wait list will be active until Saturday March 21, 2026 at 6:00 PM. Any runs that are entered in these trials at closing and pulled before the wait list deadline will be replaced, if possible, by runs in the order on the wait list and the exhibitor will be reimbursed for the number of runs replaced. If a run is pulled, but cannot be replaced, the exhibitor will not receive a refund and the dog will be considered absent from the run. Entry fees for runs on the wait list that do not get into the trial by the wait list closing date will be refunded in full.

REFUNDS

There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date in the event a dog and/or handler are injured, absent, or dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of management it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

Bitches in Season: Bitches in season are not permitted in the trial. For bitches that come into season after the closing date, a refund will be made, less \$5.00. Written notification to claim this refund must be received by the Secretary no later than 30 minutes before the start of the trial.

MOVE UPS

For Friday, dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the written request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary in writing (e-mail is accepted) no later than 5:00 PM on the Monday before the trial. Requests made after that time will NOT be accommodated.

E-mail move-ups will not be official unless acknowledged by the Trial Secretary. Dogs so moved up will be entered at the end of the running order. For Saturday and Sunday, requests for move ups must be made in writing to the Trial Secretary prior to the close of the previous day's events.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs **over the age of fifteen (15) months** that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or that have obtained AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or Approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) Breeds.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/IPL) or and AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word 'dog' is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance shall not be eligible. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Dogs under four (4) months of age are prohibited at AKC Agility Trials.

MEASURING AND HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" height division. However if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process - When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs To Be Measured List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during the day of show check-in.

MIXED HEIGHTS AND CLASSES

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Ribbons will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

First Place.....*Blue*
Second Place.....*Red*
Third Place.....*Yellow*
Fourth Place.....*White*

Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to receive a placement ribbon.

Any dog that finishes a title will receive a special rosette.

Dogs that complete their MACH or PACH title at this show will receive a special rosette and bar.

The top three placements for each height of the Pupkin Cup Tournament will receive a medallion!

FEO & FIX N GO

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

FEO allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is allowed in ANY class. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare this on the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - Toys must be non-audible
 - Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

Fix and Go On (FNG)

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place outdoors on field grass. Ring sizes are 100' x 110' and 120' x 100'.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

THE PUPKIN CUP!



Overview

Welcome to our annual PUPkin Cup Tournament! Any dog eligible to compete in agility can enter, regardless of the dog's current level in agility. You can choose to enter at your dog's regular agility height, their preferred height, or the official ISC height.

The 2026 PUPkin Cup is offering **TWO levels of ISC (International Sweepstakes Class) courses** designed by Michiel Lazeroms. The "beginner" level (A1 and J1) is approximately equivalent to Novice/Open levels of challenge. The "mid-level" (A2 and J2) is approximately equivalent to Excellent/Masters in levels of challenge. **YOU CAN ENTER ANY LEVEL REGARDLESS OF YOUR DOG'S CURRENT LEVEL IN AGILITY.**

To be eligible for a PUPkin Cup Medal, you must enter the Standard course on Friday and the Jumpers with Weaves course on Saturday at the same level. **You CAN enter BOTH levels and have two chances at a medal!** (You can also choose to just enter one class to compete for a qualifying score (for example, just the J2 course on Saturday), but you would not be eligible for a tournament medal.)

For example – If you enter A2 (the mid-level Standard) on Friday and J2 (mid-level Jumpers) on Saturday, you will be eligible to earn a placement for a tournament medal. If you enter A1 (beginner level Standard) on Friday and J1 (beginner level JWW) on Saturday, you will be eligible to earn a placement for a tournament medal. If you enter BOTH A1 and A2 Friday and J1 and J2 Saturday, you will be eligible for TWO tournament placement medals.

Scores from both runs (A1/J1 or A2/J2) will be combined and **medals awarded** for 1st through 3rd place for each height. Scores between the two levels (A1/J2 or A2/J1) cannot be combined for placements.

“Clean run” scores from the ISC Standard A2 and/or ISC JWW J2 may be used to fulfill the minimum requirements for World Team Tryouts, and A1/J1 and A2/J2 courses may be used to qualify for European Open tryouts. A “clean run” in ISC consists of a run without time or course faults. These legs must be earned at your FCI height (listed below). Please review the requirements for these team tryouts online as each year requirements may change.

Scoring for The Pupkin Cup

The dog must be entered in both the A2/J2 or A1/J1 courses on Friday and Saturday to be eligible for Pupkin Cup prizes. The Pupkin Cup will be scored across both runs on a Time + Faults basis. The fewest faults followed by the fastest time wins.

While handlers can choose to run these courses FEO, any teams that elect this option cannot place in the Pupkin Cup.

Faults such as dropped bars, missed contacts and refusals each incur a 5-point penalty, but do not eliminate the team. Eliminating faults are going off course or earning 3 or more refusals.

Purpose of ISC

The international sweepstakes class (ISC) is a non-regular class providing the dog and handler an opportunity to demonstrate their advanced training and handling skills on various international style Standard and Jumpers with Weaves courses. The rules for these classes are generally based on international rules. The variety in international agility course designs is very diverse, so handlers should be prepared to meet the "Challenge of the Day" when competing in the ISC class.

Complete rules for the ISC are available from the AKC website (<http://www.akc.org>). We encourage you to read them!

Eligibility

ISC classes are open to all dogs that are eligible to compete in AKC agility trials. At present, there are no eligibility requirements for any level of ISC – Novice dogs through Masters dogs can run any level of ISC!

While there is no Preferred Option for ISC, **dogs may still enter at their preferred jump height**; however, they will be scored against the regular division dogs jumping their regular height. For example: **16” preferred dogs will be scored against 20” regular division dogs**.

Jump Heights:

DOGS MAY BE ENTERED IN THEIR REGULAR OR PREFERRED JUMP HEIGHTS, however, only those dogs running in the height class that meets the FCI/ISC measuring cutoff (which is different than regular AKC cutoffs for 12”, 16”, 20” and 24”) may use their clean run toward the required qualification toward World Team or European Open Try Outs.

Please see the 2024 EO/AWC Tryout Rules for further details.

The FCI/ISC cutoffs for those heights are as follows:

- Small (12” jump height) – for dogs measuring 13 3/4” or less at the withers
- Medium (16” jump height) – for dogs measuring more than 13 3/4” and up to 16 7/8” at the withers
- Intermediate (20” jump height) – for dogs measuring more than 16 7/8 but less than 18 7/8” at the withers.
- Large (24” jump height) – for dogs measuring over 18 7/8” at the withers

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this Trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Dog-On-It Agility Club of Greater Orlando and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Dog-On-It Agility Club of Greater Orlando reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Dog-On-It Agility Club of Greater Orlando or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on Trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging, if a valid copy of their jump height card was sent with their entry. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Since **ring-side shade is limited**, you might consider bringing a tent or crate cover. An area between the rings will be designated for crating. The club will provide a small pool for pups should they need to cool off. Be sure to bring water for both you and your pup(s). There are trees just a short distance from the field should you desire to crate out of your vehicle in the shade.

Currently **no food vendor** is scheduled to be on site so plan to bring your own food and drink. Restaurants are available in nearby Mount Dora as well as on Orange Blossom Trail. Volunteers will have access to snacks and water throughout the day so plan to volunteer!

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

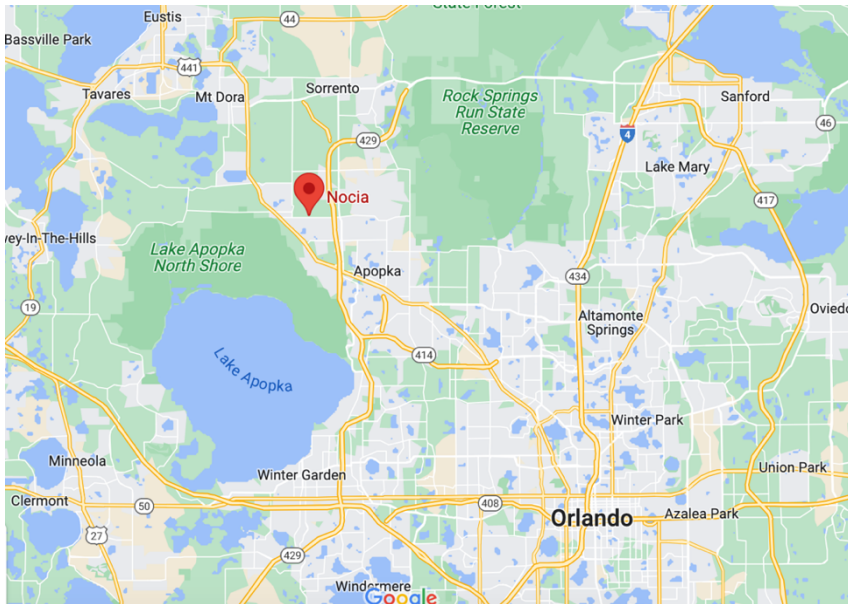

If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.
